

### Duō + verb + quantity of objects

<p>wǒ xiǎng duō chī yī wǎn fàn 我想多吃一碗饭。</p> <p>wǒ yào duō mǎi liǎng jiàn yīfu 我要多买两件衣服。</p> <p>nǐ xiǎng duō hē yī bēi kāfēi ma? 你想多喝一杯咖啡吗?</p> <p>wǒ děi duō zuò yī ge xiǎoshí de gōngkè 我得多做一个小时的功课。</p> <p>nǐ duō zhǎo le wǒ liǎng kuài 你多找了我两块。</p> <p>wǒ xiǎng duō wán yī gè xiǎoshí 我想多玩一个小时。</p> <p>Wǒ xiǎng duō shuì yīge xiǎoshí de jiào (sommeil) 我想多睡一个小时的觉。</p> <p>qǐng duō gěi wǒ yī bēi shuǐ 请多给我一杯水。</p> <p>wǒmen xiǎng duō yào sān wǎn fàn 我们想多要三碗饭。</p> <p>Nǐ xiǎng duō chī yī kuài(measure word) dàngāo ma 你想多吃一块蛋糕吗?</p> <p>Wǒ xiǎng duō kàn yī bù(measure word) diànyǐng cái shuìjiào 我想多看一部电影才睡觉</p>	<p>I want to eat one more bowl of rice</p> <p>I want to buy one more cloth</p> <p>Do you want to drink one more cup of coffee</p> <p>I have to do one more hour of homework</p> <p>You gave me \$2 more for the change I want to play for one hour more</p> <p>I want to sleep one hour more Please give me one more cup of water</p> <p>I want to have 3 more bowls of rice</p> <p>Do you want to eat one more piece of cake</p> <p>I want to watch one more movie</p>
<p><b>Duō + verb + le quantity of objects ( for a past action)</b></p> <p>nǐ duō zhǎo le wǒ yī kuài qián 你多找了我一块钱</p> <p>wǒ zuótiān duō chī le yī wǎn fàn 我昨天多吃了一碗饭</p> <p>wǒ zuótiān duō zuò le yī gè xiǎoshí de zuòyè 我昨天多做了一个小时的作业</p>	<p>You gave me a change one dollar more</p> <p>I ate one more bowl of rice yesterday</p> <p>I did one more hour of homework yesterday. zuòyè =homework</p>

diǎnr goes before a noun when diǎnr is for description of the noun

wǒ xiǎng duō chī diǎnr fàn

我想多吃点儿饭。

wǒ yào duō mǎi diǎnr yīfu

我要多买点儿衣服。

nǐ yào duō chuān diǎnr yīfu

你要多穿点儿衣服。

qǐng duō gěi wǒ diǎnr shuǐ

请多给我点儿水

I want to eat some more rice

I want to buy some more clothes

You should wear more clothes

Please give me some more water

In contrary to the above examples with diǎnr goes before the noun, the following example with diǎnr goes before the verb when diǎnr is used as adverb (for the verb, i.e. has to do something more)

wǒ děi duō diǎnr liànxí shuō zhōngwén

我得多吃点儿练习说中文。

wǒ děi duō zuò yīhuìr de gōngkè

我得多做一会儿的功课。

I have to practise speaking chinese more

I have to doing homework for a little more while
